Order

The Hon'ble Minister for Youth Welfare and Sports Department, Tamil Nadu made an announcement (No.6) on the floor of Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly on 30.3.2023 for conducting Community Skill Schools.

Announcement No. 6

1,000 New Community Skill Schools will be established/conducted across Tamil Nadu at a cost of Rs.10 Crores.

Preamble

Community Skills Schools (CSS) will provide much-needed opportunities to the young generation especially women to develop a source of income through master practitioners/community experts by sharing their domain knowledge and imparting the skill training with simple and minimally required infrastructure right in their community.

Objectives

- To help community members to understand skilling through an easy learning process, discuss ideas and provide constructive feedback.

- To facilitate knowledge sharing and learning the best practices from the local master practitioners and usage of local resources.
- To bridge the skill gaps and employable opportunities by learning from a local practitioner along with their peers.

Target

The Project aims to create 1000 CSSs in 268 blocks covering 10,000 trainees. The district wise annual and quarterly target for setting up of CSS and number of youths to be trained in the project area is given in the annexure-I.

Key steps in CSS

Step: 1 – To give wide publicity among the communities about CSS and the outcome expected out of that.

Step: 2 - Mobilize applications from eligible candidates for the position of trainer by PLF with the help of CRP EP.

Step: 3 - The applications will be evaluated with the help of RSETI / qualified agency / District Skill Training Officer.

Step: 4 – The selected trainer will be given training through an agency/ educational institute or an expert trainer to ensure standardized processes and consistent delivery of the training process.

Duration of the training programme and batch size

Duration of the CSS training programme will vary based on the sector. Both the duration and batch size will be jointly decided by the trainer, community, DPMU with the inputs of expert trainer/agency. However, each CSS will conduct only two trainings in a year.

Trainee qualification

- Must be a SHG member / SHG households.
- Age: 18-35 years (Relaxation of five years in age will be allowed for Differently abled and Widows).



- They are prepared and willing to be employed in wage (or) initiate self-employment
- 40% of the trainees should be Women, 5% differently-abled, 18% SC and 1 % ST.
- The trainees are expected to attend all the classes and be prepared to undergo assessment and certification process.

Trainer Qualification

- Age above 25 years with minimum 5 years' experience in the domain.
- Should be literate with ability to read, write and communicate.
- Should possess wealth of knowledge, skill and adequate experience in the field.
- Should dedicate time to impart training.
- Should have good credential among the community.
- Should establish skill schools in-situ.

Formation of CSS

The willing individual / enterprise to give skill training should send the proposal through PLF / BMMU for onward submission to DPMU. The proposal will be placed in the district committee for evaluation and evaluated list will be approved by the District Collector.

Selection committee

Committee will be formed under the Chairmanship of the District Collector constituting Project Director TNSRLM, Director – RSETI, a member from Industrial Association, Assistant Director (Livelihood) and the Block Manager.

Fund Release

Based on the proposal submitted by the DMMU funds will be released by SMMU and in turn released to Panchayat Level Federation for release to Community Skills School.

Monitoring

- The progress will be reviewed by the Project Director TNSRLM at the review meetings conducted periodically.
- Field visits will be undertaken by zonal officers across various administrative levels during the programme.


Timelines
