The TNSRLM has been undertaking systematic approach to prevent Child Marriage, Domestic Violence against Women and Children, Child Sexual Abuse and towards achieving this, one active SHG Member from each SHG is identified as Gender Point Person who will be the spokes women for identifying the above issue and create awareness about the gender interventions undertaken by TNSRLM. During the last year, 47 Gender Resource Centres have been established in all 37 districts to resolve gender related issues and for creation of awareness among various CBOs like Gender Collectives, PLF-SAC, Block Level Gender Forum and among the SHG women.

During the last two years, intensive campaign in the name of Gender Violence Campaign has been done on the Day of 25th Nov 2022 i.e. International Day of Elimination of Violence against Women in the state for creation of awareness with the participation of the Gender Institutional Mechanisms such as Gender Point Person (GPP), Gender Collectives, Panchayat Level Federation (Social Action Committee), Block Level Gender Forum (BLGF) and Gender Resources Centres (GRCs).

Anadusha@ushaa aa in Mah . http://www.tamilnadussaman asa Out of the learnings from the above intensive campaign commenced on 25<sup>th</sup> Nov – International Day of Elimination of Violence against Women, it is understood that 47% of the women in the state don't realise that they have been subject to domestic violence and more particularly during COVID-19 and Post-COVID, women are put into lot of pressure and violence and they don't know the legal protections available to them through various Acts issued either by Central or State Government. Hence, in-order to give them the awareness on the following Acts which are meant for the benefit of women and children and these one-day legal awareness training will be imparted to the CBOs like PLF, PLF-SAC, Block Level Gender Forum, BLF, GRC Manager and Gender Collectives at the Village Panchayat Level and BMMUs at Block level, DMMUs at District level and State Level staff at a cost of 3.23 crore during the year 24-25 as follows,

In furtherance to this the block level staff in 388 blocks and district level staffs and Resource Persons at District, Block and Village panchayat will also be trained by the State Level Master Trainer and the One Day Legal Awareness will be done to the CBOs and Gender Institutional Mechanisms such as Gender Point Person (GPP), Gender Collectives, Panchayat Level Federation (Social Action Committee), Block Level Gender Forum (BLGF) and GRC Manager.
