### Order:

Tamil Nadu State Rural Livelihoods Mission is taking systematic efforts to reduce poverty and vulnerability of the vulnerable households, viz., Differently abled, Elders, Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTG), Tribal, Transgender, etc., through mobilizing them into special Self Help Groups consisting of 6 to 8 members.

In the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited, Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister / Honb'le Minister of Youth and Sports Development has announced on the Floor of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly as "3. பழங்குடியினர், முதியோர், மாற்றுத்திறணாளிகள் மற்றும் திருநங்கையர் உள்ளிட்ட 2,500 சிறப்பு சுய உதவி குழுக்களுக்கு நடப்பாண்டில் 25 கோடி ரூபாய் வாழ்வாதார நிதி அளிக்கப்படும். விளிம்பு நிலையிலுள்ள பழங்குடியினர், முதியோர், மாற்றுத்திறணாளிகள், திருநங்கையர் உள்ளிட்ட 2,500 சிறப்பு சுய உதவிக் குழுக்களின் சமூக, பொருளாதார தரத்தை மேம்படுத்திடவும், உகந்த வாழ்வாதார நடவடிக்கைகளில் ஈடுபட ஊக்குவிக்கும் விதத்திலும், வாழ்வாதார நிதியாக நடப்பாண்டில் 25 கோடி ரூபாய் வழங்கப்படும்..."

- Formation of Special SHGs: During the year 2025-26, it has been proposed to form 9340 Special SHGs, viz., 4500 Elderly SHGs, 1300 PWD SHGs, 3500 Tribal / PVTG SHGs and 40 Transgender SHGs. District wise target has been communicated vide the reference 1st cited.
- Training to Special SHGs: 3 days training shall be given to the Animators & Representative of newly formed special SHGs Group Dynamics, Governance, Book keeping and Financial Management. Further, 2 days training shall be given to all the members of the newly formed special SHGs.
- Panchasutras: The special SHGs should follow panchasutra, viz., regular meetings, regular savings, regular internal lending, regular repayment and up to date maintenance of books of accounts.
- Meetings: Regular meetings should be conducted by the SHGs in order to ensure transparency in all its activities. It is desirable that the special SHGs should have conducted at least fortnightly meetings.
- Savings: The special SHGs should save a minimum amount of Rs. 100/- per month or above as decided unanimously in the group meetings. The savings amount should be kept in the bank account and should be operated by an able bodied member of the Special Groups.
- Internal Lending & Repayment: The savings amount may be lent among the members as loans and the requirement may be prioritised based on the purpose like their children's education, medical needs, livelihood activities, etc. The amount shall be repaid regularly with a maximum interest rate of 12% per annum or as decided by the Special Group.

#### Financial Assistance

 Revolving Fund (RF): The SHGs which are 3 months old and completed the SHG member / A&R trainings are eligible for Revolving Fund of Rs. 15,000 per SHG. The RF amount form part of their group corpus which will help the SSHGs in getting Bank loans, calculated at the rate of 5 times of their group corpus.

- Vulnerability Reduction Fund (VRF): The members of the SSHGs who are vulnerable and aspire to take up individual activities shall be provided with VRF at a maximum of Rs. 25,000 per member which need to be repaid to the PLF along with the interest rate of 6% per annum.
- Bank Linkage: The SHGs which are 6 months old and received Revolving Fund and credit rated shall be eligible to get linkage from the Banks with a minimum of Rs. 1.00 lakh or 5 times of their group corpus.
- Livelihood Fund: In order to support the special SHGs to take up gainful economic activities, Livelihood Fund at the rate of Rs. 1.00 lakh are proposed to be provided to 2,678 Special SHGs, viz., 1,164 Elderly SHGs, 1,164 PWD SHGs and 350 Tribal / Transgender SHGs during 2025-26 as per the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited. The District wise targets have already been communicated to all the districts which is enclosed in Annexure 1, 2 and 3. The Livelihood assistance will be provided to Special SHGs which fulfil the following conditions.
  - The Special SHG should be one year old.
  - The Special SHG should follow Panchasutra.
  - The Special SHG is FDM compliant and the SHG shall be having an id in NRLM portal.
  - The Special SHGs should be federated with PLF concerned
  - There shall be a Business / Economic Activity Plan by the proposed special SHGs.

Further, the proposals for Livelihood Assistance to eligible Special SHGs in the prescribed format given in the Annexure-4 and should be sent only after ensuring FDM compliance in the MIS portal by the concerned

Blocks and Districts and the proposals should be sent through the District Collectors concerned.

The expenditure of the same shall be booked under AAP 2025-26 B2.5.3.2, B2.5.3.3 and B2.5.3.4.
